You need to equip them with the tools they need to be confident in and around water so they don't lose out on the health benefits of exercise, the opportunities to bond with family and friends and the sense of accomplishment when they learn new skills. The Y encourages grandparents, parents and caregivers to take an active role in child's safety by ensuring they learn how to swim and by practicing these six evidence-based interventions in your household and local community.


